Dr Anthony Joseph has had nearly 60 years involvement with tracing Jewish family trees and the family histories that bring them to life. His talk will partly be a personal account of his own Anglo-Jewish ancestry going back to 1670, and partly about the exciting new databases in many countries that are now available to researchers – and much more besides!

We welcome our speaker to Australia, with his wife Helene, on a brief trip down-under. Dr Joseph has been President of the Jewish Genealogical Society of Great Britain since 1998 and former President of the Jewish Historical Society of England, 1994-1996. He has for many years been the UK Representative of the AJHS and is well known to many members for his numerous publications on Jewish research and ancestry including contributing editor to the journal AVOTAYNU for the UK since its inception.
